1901 Grille Dress Code

OAK HILL COUNTRY CLUB

To ensure an atmosphere of comfort, elegance, and mutual respect, we kindly ask that all patrons observe the club's dress code. Members are encouraged to use good judgment and discretion. Children over the age of six are also expected to comply with these guidelines. The Traditions Committee oversees and upholds these standards with care and consideration.

MEN

- To maintain a polished and refined atmosphere, sports coats are highly encouraged, though not required.
- Acceptable attire includes collared shirts, turtlenecks, and sweaters paired with slacks. Shirts must remain tucked in. When wearing a sweater, a collared shirt is required underneath.
- V-neck and crew neck shirts are permitted only when worn with a sport coat.
- Dress jeans are acceptable. *Please refer to the club's denim policy for additional guidance.*
- Athletic pullovers, shorts, sandals or open-toed footwear, and hats are not permitted.

WOMEN

- Appropriate attire includes blazers, dresses, blouses, sweaters, skirts, pantsuits, and slacks.
- Skirts and dresses should reflect tasteful and modest styling.
- Dress jeans are permitted. *Please refer to the club's denim policy for additional guidance.*
- Leggings, yoga pants, shorts, and hats are not permitted.



Denim Dress Code

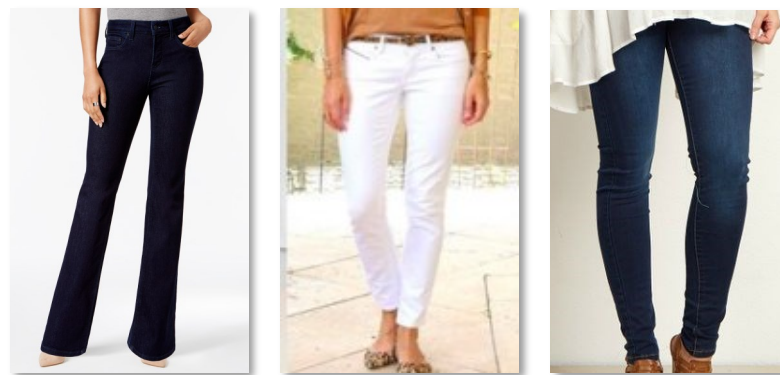
Tailored dress jeans are permitted anywhere and anytime, throughout the Clubhouse, including the Golf Shop and Ladies Card Room.

Dress jeans must be tailored and free from holes, tears, frayed bottoms and shall not be distressed, cargo, baggy or acid washed.

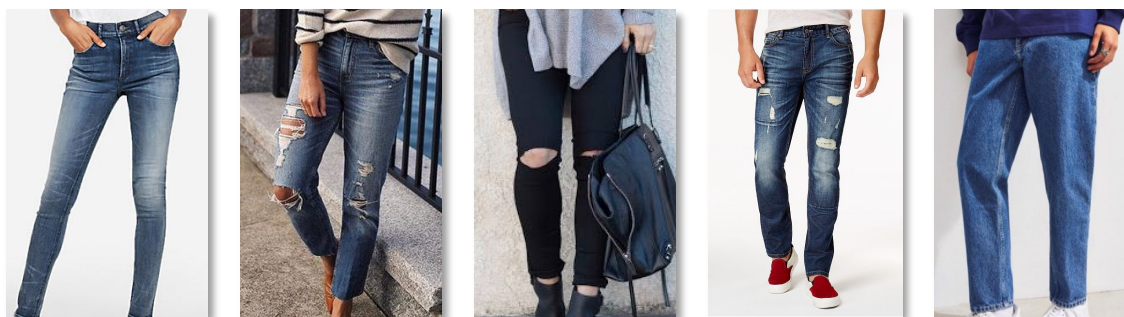
Women's colored jeans are acceptable.

Gentlemen are encouraged, but not required, to wear a sport coat along with their jeans.

Hat Policy

OAK HILL COUNTRY CLUB

Men are only permitted to wear hats on the lower level of the Clubhouse, except the Bowling Alley, where hats are not permitted.

Women may wear hats or visors coordinating with their outfits in the Clubhouse.

Outside of the Clubhouse, including the patios, hats and visors are allowed but must be worn with the bill facing forward.

Men's Dress Code

**Please note that the Clubhouse Dress Code does not apply to the 1901 Grille*

ACCEPTABLE

- Hats are only permitted on the lower level of the Clubhouse, except the Bowling Alley, where hats are not permitted. Hat, caps and visors must be worn with the bill facing forward. *See Club Hat Policy.*
- Dress jeans must be tailored and free of holes, tears and frays. Gentlemen are encouraged, but not required, to wear a sport coat along with their jeans.
- Men's shirts must have sleeves and collars and must be worn inside one's trousers unless designed to be worn outside like 'UnTuck It' and Bahama shirts.
- Golf attire is acceptable at all times in the Clubhouse unless otherwise specified for an event. *See Men's Golf Dress Code.*
- V-neck and crew neck shirts are permitted only when worn with a sport coat.

UNACCEPTABLE

- Sandals/open toe shoes are prohibited in all locations except the Pool Complex.
- Athletic type t-shirts, including team jerseys.
- Apparel containing slogans.
- Cut-off apparel.
- Cargo pants, cargo shorts, warm-up suits, jogging attire, and gym attire unless walking directly from the parking lot to the Fitness Center/Locker Rooms using the lower level entrance.

Women's Dress Code

**Please note that the Clubhouse Dress Code does not apply to the 1901 Grille*

ACCEPTABLE

- Shirts and blouses must be worn inside slacks or skirts, unless designed to be worn outside.
- Hats or visors coordinating with an outfit are permitted inside. *See Club Hat Policy.*
- Length of skirts, skorts, and shorts must be of a tasteful and respectful length at all times.
- Dress jeans are permitted throughout the Club at anytime. *See Club Denim Policy.*
- Golf attire is acceptable at all times in the Clubhouse unless otherwise specified for an event. *See Women's Golf Dress Code.*
- Women's fashion leggings are permitted.
- Dress sandals/open toe shoes are allowed.

UNACCEPTABLE

- Rubber flip-flops or plastic slip-on sandals are not acceptable except at the Pool Complex.
- Athletic type t-shirts, including team jerseys.
- Apparel containing slogans.
- Cut-off apparel.
- Cargo pants, cargo shorts, warm-up suits, jogging suits, athletic leggings, and gym attire unless walking directly from the parking lot to the Fitness Center/locker rooms using the lower-level entrance.

Men's Golf Dress Code

OAK HILL COUNTRY CLUB

ACCEPTABLE

- Golf shorts or Bermuda style shorts must be mid-thigh or longer.
- Collared shirts, short and long sleeve mock turtleneck shirts that are tucked in are permitted.
- Long trousers must be neat in appearance.
- Close toe shoes must be worn at all times and have non-penetrating spikes.
- Hooded "sweaters" made by golf clothing manufactures and crested with small logos (3" x 3" or smaller) are allowed to be worn on the golf courses and practice areas if a collared shirt is worn underneath. Hooded jackets with zippers are allowed.
- Hat, caps and visors must be worn with the bill facing forward. *See Club Hat Policy.* Please take your hat off when entering the main and upper levels of the Clubhouse.

UNACCEPTABLE

- Cargo pants and shorts (cargo pockets defined as side exterior pockets). Side interior pockets are allowed.
- Denim shorts or pants (dungarees or blue jeans).
- T-shirts, tank tops and athletic team jerseys.
- Fitness attire (jogging suits, gym shorts).
- Hats or visors not worn with the bill forward facing. *See Club Hat Policy.*
- Changing shoes in the parking lot is not permitted. Please change in the Locker Room.
- Hooded "sweatshirts" with large logos (larger than 3" x 3") and/or have large seamed front pockets (kangaroo pouches) are not allowed to be worn on the golf courses or practice areas.



Women's Golf Dress Code

ACCEPTABLE

- Length of skirts, shorts, or skorts must be of a tasteful and respectful length at all times.
- Women's shirts and blouses must be worn inside slacks or skirts, unless designed to be worn outside.
- Sleeveless shirts and dresses must have a collar or high neck.
- Shoes must be worn at all times and have non-penetrating spikes.
- Women's leggings must be covered by a skirt, skort, or shorts. Fashion leggings are permitted inside the Clubhouse without being covered by a skirt, skort, or shorts.

UNACCEPTABLE

- Cargo pants and shorts (cargo pockets defined as side exterior pockets). Side interior pockets are allowed.
- Denim shorts or pants (dungarees or blue jeans).
- T-shirts, tank tops and athletic team jerseys.
- Fitness attire (jogging suits, gym shorts, hooded sweatshirts, yoga pants).
- Hats or visors not worn with the bill forward facing. *See Club Hat Policy.*
- Halter, tube, or strapless tops.
- Changing shoes in the parking lot is not permitted. Please change in the Locker Room.
- Hooded "sweatshirts" with large logos (larger than 3" x 3") and/or have large seamed front pockets (kangaroo pouches) are not allowed to be worn on the golf courses or practice areas.



Cottage Dress Code

Shirts must be worn at all times while utilizing any of the outdoor spaces at the Cottages.

Sleepwear is not to be worn outdoors on the back patio overlooking the East Course.





Sports Complex Building

OAK HILL COUNTRY CLUB

Shorts (exercise or Bermuda), athletic type t-shirts, warm-up suits, athletic leggings, caps, hats and visors may be worn in the Sports Complex Building.

Proper footwear must be worn (sneakers) for Platform Tennis.

Tennis

Regulation tennis shoes (smooth-soled court shoes) are required.

Collared and collarless tennis shirts are allowed along with tennis style athletic shorts.

Collared, collarless and/or sleeveless tennis dresses are allowed along with tennis skirts/shorts; must be of a tasteful and respectful length at all times.

Tennis warm-ups are permitted.

Bowling Alley

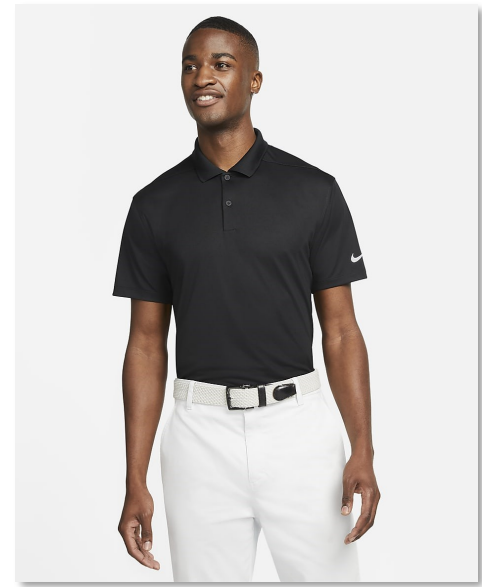
